Activities of the Year 2023 - 2024

The Academic Year 2023 – 2024 witnessed the execution of a wide range of activities which are presented in the following sections:

Induction Cum Orientation for batch 2023 - 2025 - The Induction Cum Orientation for the batch 2023 – 2025 was held on August 3, 2023 at 11:00 a.m. The event was hosted by Mrs. F. Marbaniang, who opened with a welcome speech and graciously welcomed the Chief Guest, Most Rev. Victor Lyngdoh, Arch Bishop of Shillong Diocese. The Induction Ceremony was conducted by Dr. (Mrs.) R. M. Tongper, during which the newly inducted student-teachers in attendance affirmed their commitment to the college and its values. The college rules were also explained before conclusion of the programme. During the second session, the newly inducted student- teachers were oriented to the Course structure and content by the Academic Committee.
